

United Against Bullying School Case Study: Creating a bullying pro-forma to track incidents

How Chenderit School, East Midlands, created a bullying pro-forma to use with the victim, perpetrators, families and wider school community to improve communication

Context of our anti-bullying work

To report bullying in a more formal manner as the school adopts a more processed protocol in communicating the bullying findings and actions to parents/children and the school.

What we hoped to achieve

Improved communication of the actions taken and to build in a review process to check after the event outcomes and achievements in further supporting the victim.

The action we took

Design and create a bullying pro-forma for Heads of Learning to use with the victim, perpetrators, families and wider school community.

Impact and outcomes of the work

Improved communication and support, especially for the victim of bullying. Being able to return and review the progress made/support provided.

What we have learned

This has helped a great deal to inform the community what action/s are taken by the school and to review the support offered to meet the needs of the student/s.
