

# United Against Bullying School Case Study: Raising awareness of the Young Carers in school

How Gordon Primary School ensured the school community understands who Young Carers are and how to support them

## Context of our anti-bullying work

- Sometimes children and staff don't always know the children who are young carers
- Sometimes a parent/carer might not view their child as a young carer either
- We wanted to raise awareness and to signpost support

## What we hoped to achieve

Raised awareness so Children, Parents and Carers, staff might seek support for Young Carers

#### The action we took

- We added Young Carers as a CPOMs category in the Autumn Term DSL's monitor known Young Carers in monthly CP meetings
- Staff completed ABA CPD on Young Carers
- We held a Young Carers Assembly and marked Young Carers Action Day
- We signpost support in our Newsletter, display posters on the stairs and in the Office Reception
- This term we have signed up to Greenwich Young Carers Project
