## What is the United Against Bullying programme?

The United Against Bullying programme is the Anti-Bullying Alliance's free whole school anti-bullying programme. It supports schools to reduce bullying and improve the wellbeing of all children, focusing on those most at risk, including those with protected characteristics.

The overall aim of the programme is to establish United Against Bullying Schools. These are schools that have evidenced their work to reduce bullying and improve the wellbeing of all pupils.

**The programme is free for all schools in England. Participating schools receive:**



Access to the online United Against Bullying Hub, including;

- A 360° audit and action planning tool
- An online pupil questionnaire to ascertain levels of bullying and wellbeing in your school
- Specialist tailored resources to support you to implement your action plan, including case studies



CPD online and face to face training and invitations to other special events



An interactive anti-bullying Parent Information Tool to provide to parents

## What are the benefits?

- Tailored support to reduce bullying and improve the wellbeing of pupils, especially for those most at-risk
- Easily evidence your anti-bullying practice as a school, including to Governors and Ofsted

## What are the deadlines?

There are three steps to complete to become a United Against Bullying School:

### 1. Plan

Complete a baseline audit and baseline pupil questionnaire by **Friday 29th September 2023.**

Schools who have evidenced the improvements they have made over the course of the programme will be awarded with either Gold, Silver or Bronze 'United Against Bullying School' status in March 2024.

### 2. Do

Develop and implement the action plan and undertake training by **Friday 15th December 2023.**

### 3. Review

Complete a final audit, final pupil questionnaire and submit evidence by **Friday 23rd February 2024.**
